Estonian Academy of Security Sciences (EASS) announces an open call for high-quality original articles to be published in 2021 in the academic journal *Proceedings*.

The Proceedings of the Estonian Academy of Security Sciences is a non-profit journal that publishes well-documented and analysed studies on full range of contemporary security issues, especially internal security and law enforcement. The journal is indexed in the EBSCO database as well.

The 20th issue of the Proceedings is focusing on the impact of COVID-19 on internal security. The subtitle of the next number is Security challenges during COVID-19: lessons learned and perspectives.

Priority is given to works addressing this topic, however, studies based on original empirical data devoted to security issues also befit the scope of the journal (e.g. external border, future threat scenarios, safety, migration, radicalization, hybrid conflict, use of mass data, disaster management, innovative technologies and education).
