- Principal institutional responsibilities in the development and use of capabilities to counter hybrid threats and effective ways for future interagency cooperation.
- Mine-set change challenges to achieve resilience in hybrid warfare.
- Opportunities of enhanced cooperation between NATO, European Union and Partners in countering hybrid warfare: Political and military dimensions.
- The role of innovative methods in Education, Training, Exercises and Evaluation in countering hybrid warfare.
